American General has partnered with Ebix, Inc. and ExamOne to develop AG Quick Ticket powered by LifeSpeed. Producers can access and complete an online application via single sign-on to www.agquickticket.com or through American General's eStation website that provides access to a wealth of product and client information.

Once submitted, the application information is electronically transferred to ExamOne. ExamOne will perform a tele-interview for complete Part A and Part B information, obtain wet signatures from the client, and submit the Part A and Part B applications and all ancillary forms to American General for processing.
